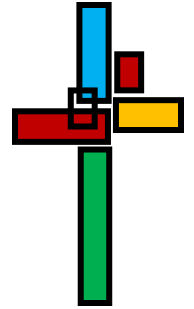

ENSURING A SAFE SETTING

Please help us maintain a safe space for all. We must follow the directives of our BC Public Health Authority CDC, BC Provincial Medical Health Officer, WorkSafe BC, and the BC Synod to keep everyone safe during the COVID-19 pandemic.

We can only accomplish this if we all do our part in a spirit of cooperation.

At all times entering the church is completely voluntary, and everyone does so at their own risk. It is important for individuals and families to take responsibility for protecting themselves and others.

If it is last minute, please call from the parking lot.

Recognize that the staff may be engaged and they will respond as soon as they are available.

The washrooms are available only for emergent use. Please plan accordingly.

Please do not bring the following items into the church: beverages, food, bags, and other unnecessary items.

Please keep all items you bring in with you.

Please comply with all signage inside the church as well as on the church property.

Please sanitize hands upon arrival with the Health Canada approved Hand Sanitizer.

Upon entering please sign the Log-In Sign in sheet. This information must be kept for a minimum of 30 days and upon request be made available to the BC Provincial Medical Health Officer

We are social distancing. Please maintain the 2 metres physical distancing at all times except with those in your own household.

Please place your offering envelope in the basket provided inside the front entrance.

Food bank items may be placed in the blue bins provided outside of the church entrance.

Masks are required at all times while you are in the Church. This does not limit social distancing.

High-risk areas are disinfected regularly.

The Narthex is limited to a maximum of 3 people.

Please stay home if you are sick, even if you have the slightest symptoms or feelings of sickness, especially if these include upper respiratory or flu-like symptoms. You are encouraged to use the COVID-19 Self Assessment Tool for BC
