

Mark your calendars for **February 22** for our second *Conversations Across the Church* online event!



through service, compassion, and justice in the world.

Within the ELCIC, diaconal ministers are rostered leaders called to ministries of word and service. They serve in congregations, schools, hospitals, social service agencies and other community organizations, helping the church live out its faith in daily life while serving the needs of the wider community.



Addressing Anti-Judaism During Lent and Eastertide

Last year, the Consultation on Common Texts (CCT) guidance on addressing anti-Judaism and *proposed alternate readings for Palm/Passion Sunday and Good Friday, along with revisions to the*

lectionary for the season of Easter and the time after Pentecost. This provisional update to the Revised Common Lectionary (RCL) is now commended to the churches for a three-year trial period, beginning in Advent of 2025. ELCIC worship leaders are invited to integrate these revisions into worship planning.




