Bishops and Assistants to the Bishops are once again offering weekly sermons for congregational use, available from May through October.

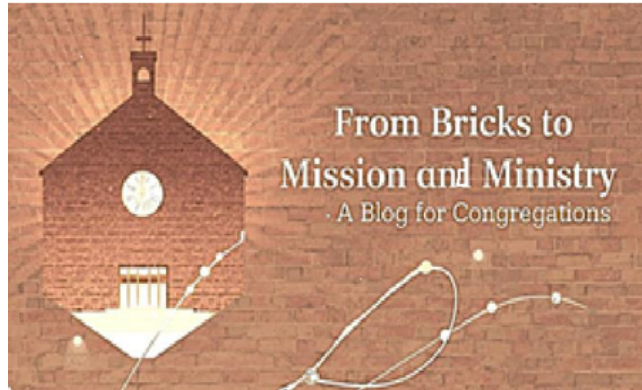

Every Square Foot Counts: Generous and Solvent: The Case for Fair Pricing



Join us on Zoom for the May session. This session moves from principle to practice: How do congregations calculate and communicate fair pricing? How do you hold a values-based conversation about money with long-standing partners?

- Work through a simple cost-recovery calculation for your own building
- Explore language for transitioning groups from informal to formal arrangements

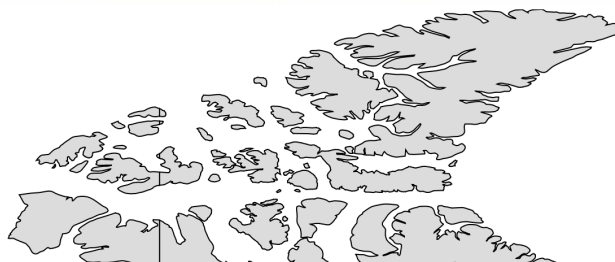

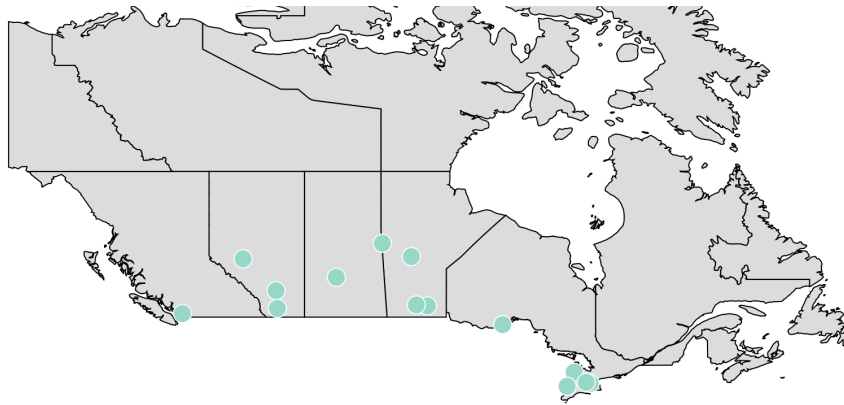
