

(ELCIC) and the Anglican Church of Canada (ACC) are pleased to announce the recipients of the 2024 Companion of the Worship Arts (CWA). The CWA is awarded every three years in recognition of significant contributions to the worship life of both churches. 2. Archbishop & Primate Linda Nicholls Announces Plan to Retire

In an April 9, 2024 statement, Archbishop Linda Nicholls, Primate of the Anglican Church of Canada, announced that she will step down from her role on September 15, 2024. Archbishop Nicholls was elected as the 14th Primate of the Anglican Church of Canada on July 13, 2019.
